1. Introduction

Papaya Institute Inc ("we," "us," or "our") is committed to protecting the privacy and personal information of our students, who are typically between the ages of 13 and 17 years old. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard the personal information of students who participate in our group virtual classes and educational programs.

2. Information We Collect
